CALL TO ORDER

The Canvassing Board meeting was called to order by Judge Kenneth Gottlieb at 1:00 p.m.

Motion to approve minutes from last Canvassing Board meeting was granted by Canvassing Board members.

BOARD TO CONSIDER VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOTS

Chief Mary Hall briefed Canvassing Board members on Vote-by-Mail ballots. 577,000 Vote-by-Mail ballots were mailed, 228,000 Vote-by-Mail ballots were received. There are 174 Vote-by-Mail (VBM) ballot certificates with no signature, 41 VBM ballot certificates with signature differ, 79 VBM ballot certificates signed by other than voter, 100 ballots returned by voters that moved away. Today is the first day of early voting and about 13,000 people has voted so far.

- Vote-by-Mail ballots presented to Canvassing Board members for review and to provide guidance as of voter intent.
- Ballots already reviewed by the board for voter intent and duplicated were presented to Canvassing Board members to verify that ballots were duplicated correctly.
- (158) duplicated ballots need to be reviewed by the Canvassing Board.



- (227) Military and Overseas Vote-by-Mail ballots available for review. Motion to skip UOCAVA review and to move them directly to Public Inspection was approved by the Canvassing Board members.
- During Public Inspection on October 15th, viewers requested for few ballots to be reviewed by the Canvassing Board members for voter intent.
