CALL TO ORDER

The Canvassing Board meeting was called to order by Judge Kenneth Gottlieb at 1:00 p.m.

Motion to approve minutes from last Canvassing Board meeting was granted by Canvassing Board members.

BOARD TO CONSIDER VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOTS

Chief Deputy Mary Hall briefed Canvassing Board on Early Voting and Vote-by-Mail. 297,586 people voted early and 421,642 Vote-by-Mail ballots were received so far. A total of 719,228 (59.9%) voters have cast their vote as of today. Military and Overseas voters can either fax or mail their ballot with the voter certificate back to the Elections office. Once the Military and Overseas ballot is received, it is duplicated and presented to the Canvassing Board to review.

- Review of Vote-by-Mail Ballot Cure Affidavits
 - (9) Vote-by-Mail ballots returned with no signatures and voters submitted Cure Affidavit. Motion to approve Vote-by-Mail ballots with Cure Affidavit and to tabulate was granted by the Canvassing Board Members.
 - (1) Vote-by-Mail ballot returned with signature differ and voter provided Cure Affidavit. Motion to accept ballot was approved by the Canvassing Board members.
- Vote-by-Mail ballots duplicated after reviewed by the board for voter intent are presented to Canvassing Board members to verify that ballots were duplicated correctly.
