Shall general obligation bonds of the City of Coral Springs be issued in an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$27,352,000, bearing interest not exceeding the maximum rate allowable by law, maturing within 20 years from the issuance date, and payable from ad valorem taxes for the public safety projects described in Resolution 2017-046.

Parks and recreation infrastructure is in need of upgrade, construction, expansion, furnishing or other improvement. Shall general obligation bonds of the City of Coral Springs be issued in an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$26,000,000, bearing interest not exceeding the maximum rate allowable by law, maturing within 20 years from the issuance date, and payable from ad valorem taxes for the parks and recreation projects described in Resolution 2017-046.

Certain streets and drainage areas in the City are in need of upgrade, construction, expansion, furnishing or other improvements. 2. Parks, Recreation and Leisure Projects General Obligation Bonds

To acquire, construct, equip, renovate, replace and improve parks, recreation and leisure facilities and pay related costs shall Pompano Beach, Florida issue bonds not exceeding \$56,000,000, in one or more series, bearing interest not exceeding the maximum legal rate, maturing not later than 30 years from their issuance date(s), pledging the City's full faith and credit and ad valorem revenues collected to pay such bonds, all as described in Resolution No. 2018-01?

To acquire, construct, equip, renovate, replace and improve police, fire, emergency management and lifeguard facilities and pay related costs, shall Pompano Beach, Florida issue bonds not exceeding \$46,000,000, in one or more series, bearing interest not exceeding the maximum legal rate, maturing not later than 30 years from their issuance date(s), pledging the City's full faith and credit and ad valorem revenues collected to pay such bonds, all as described in Resolution No. 2018-01?
