ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF VOTER ID

When voting early or voting at a polling place, Florida law requires voters to present a picture ID with signature. Acceptable forms of ID are:

- Florida driver's license
- Florida identification card issued by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles
- United States passport
- Debit or credit card
- Military identification
- Student identification
- Retirement center identification
- Neighborhood association identification
- Public assistance identification

ID required and checked at the polls is used solely to confirm the voter's identity, not to verify the voter's ID number or address.

If the voter's picture ID does not contain a signature, an additional document with signature may be used.

THREE WAYS TO VOTE

1. Early Voting—voters are allowed to vote at any of the early voting locations.
2. Absentee Ballot—voters can vote by mail.
3. Election Day—voters may only vote at their assigned precinct.

**Pre-arranged pick-up of an absentee ballot starts the day after the last day that an absentee ballot can be requested to be mailed. Ballots can only be picked-up at the Voting Equipment Center.*

ABSENTEE BALLOT GUIDELINES

- Requires a written request signed by the voter if the request is to mail the absentee ballot to an address other than the one on file in FVRS. Exception: an absent uniformed service voter or an overseas voter.

- Voter is allowed to cure the missing signature on an absentee ballot certificate if he or she completes an absentee ballot affidavit and provides an ID on or before 5:00 p.m. on the day before election day.
- Pick-up of an absentee ballot on election day requires completion of an emergency affidavit.
- It is a first degree misdemeanor for any person who provides or offers to provide, and any person who accepts a pecuniary or other benefit in exchange for physically possessing more than 2 absentee ballots per election in addition to his or her own ballot or a ballot belonging to an immediate family member.

3. ELECTION DAY

The polls are open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on election day.

- Have you moved recently?
- Have you changed your name?
- Would you like to change your party?
