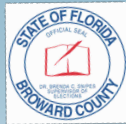

For this upcoming August 24th Primary Election, please remember that Florida is a closed primary state and only voters with a major party affiliation are eligible to vote in a primary when electing that party's nominee for the general election. All voters, regardless of affiliation may vote for nonpartisan races and issues.

Vote by mail, vote early or go to the polls on Tuesday, August 24th and cast your vote with confidence!
