

# PUBLIC NOTICE

Public notice is hereby given that, pursuant to Florida Statutes Section 102.141(7), the Broward County Canvassing Board will continue to oversee the recount process commencing on Thursday, November 15, at 3 p.m., or such earlier time as circumstances permit, including to conduct a logic and accuracy test of the applicable equipment, and on Friday, November 16, at 6 a.m., and day to day thereafter until complete, for the manual recounts for any applicable races as directed by the Secretary of State, which may include the following Statewide Offices (as determined by the Secretary of State):

1. Governor
2. United States Senator
3. Commissioner of Agriculture and Consumer Services

And any local offices as determined by the Canvassing Board, which may include (if any):

1. Plantation Mayor
2. Pompano Beach Mayor
3. West Park City Commissioner Seat 1
4. Walnut Creek Community Development District 3

The manual recount will continue from day to day for the affected races until completed.

The Reconvening of the Canvassing Board and all recounts will be held at the Voting Equipment Center, 1501 N.W. 40<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Lauderhill, Florida 33315.
