



*Pursuant to a Preliminary Injunction issued by the United States District Court and an Appeals ruling issued by the United States Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals on Thursday, November 15, 2018, the Broward County Supervisor of Elections, Brenda C. Snipes, issues the following Notice the Public:*

## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

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Effective immediately, the Broward County Supervisor of Elections allows all voters who have been belatedly notified they have submitted a **mismatched signature ballot** to cure their ballot by Saturday, November 17, 2018, at 5:00 p.m. Such ballots shall be cured in the same manner and with the same proof a mismatched signature ballot could have otherwise been cured before November 5, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.

Anyone who voted by mail can cure in the manner provided by the district court's order if he or she signs an affidavit or declaration, to be provided by the

Secretary of State of the State of Florida  
or the county voting authorities,  
affirming under penalty of perjury that  
he or she did not receive actual notice of  
the signature defect until after 5 p.m.  
on Thursday, November 1, 2018.

Please complete the attached Cure  
Affidavit, and produce *Tier 1*  
identification, and if you do not have  
those forms of ID, produce *Tier 2*  
identification.

Tier 1 Identification

*ID that includes your name and photograph:* Florida identification card issued by the DHSMV, Florida Driver's License, United States passport, debit or credit card, or military, student, retirement center, neighborhood association, or public assistance ID, veteran health ID card issued by U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, a Florida license to carry a concealed weapon or firearm, or an employee ID card issued by any branch, department, agency, or entity of the Federal Government, the state, a county, or a municipality;

**OR if you do not have one of the above forms of ID, use one of these instead:**

Tier 2 Identification

*ID that shows your name and current residence address:* current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or government document (excluding voter ID card).
