WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE

- Only voters who are registered Democrats or Republicans may vote in the Presidential Preference Primary Election.
- All voters residing in the following municipalities are eligible to vote in the Municipal Elections.
 - ✓ Lauderdale-by-the-Sea (Mayor)
 - ✓ Lighthouse Point (Mayor)
 - ✓ Pembroke Pines (Mayor & District 2)
 - ✓ Pompano Beach (3 Charter Questions)
