The semi-finalist will be notified and their application will then be sent to the State Scholarship Chair along with a recommendation letter and a verified voter registration.

The Chair will forward copies of the applications to members of the Scholarship Committee for evaluation. The committee will announce the scholarship recipients at the 2019 Summer Conference.

There are many students from and around Broward County that could benefit greatly from this scholarship opportunity, so please make sure the applications are available to all eligible students in Broward County.
