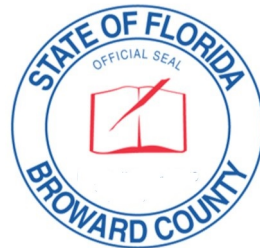

THREE~WAYS TO VOTE...

1. **Vote-by-Mail**—voters can vote by mail using pre-paid postage envelope.
2. **Early Voting**—voters may vote at any of the early voting locations.
3. **Election Day**—voters may only vote at their assigned polling place.

ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF VOTER ID

When voting early or voting at a polling place, Florida law requires voters to present a picture ID with signature. Acceptable forms of ID are:

- Florida Driver's License
- Florida identification card issued by the Department of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles
- United States passport
- Debit or credit card
- Military identification
- Student identification
- Retirement center identification
- Neighborhood association identification
- Public assistance identification
- Veteran health identification
- Licenses to carry a concealed weapon or firearm
- Issued employee identification cards

ID required and checked at the polls is used solely to confirm the voter's identity, not to verify the voter's ID number or address.

If the voter's picture ID does not contain a signature, an additional document with signature may be used.

**Pick-up of a ballot starts the day after the last day that a ballot can be requested to be mailed. Ballots can only be picked-up at the Voting Equipment Center.*

VOTE-BY-MAIL GUIDELINES

- A written request signed by the voter is required if the request is to mail a ballot to an address other than the one on file in FVRS. Exception: an absent uniformed service voter or an overseas voter.
- Voter is allowed to cure the missing signature on ballot certificate if he or she completes a ballot affidavit and provides an ID on or before 5:00 p.m. on the day before election day.
- Pick-up of ballot on election day requires completion of an emergency affidavit.
- It is a first degree misdemeanor for any person who provides or offers to provide, and any person who accepts a pecuniary or other benefit in exchange for physically possessing more than 2 ballots per election in addition to his or her own ballot or a ballot belonging to an immediate family member.
