BROWARD COUNTY SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS - ELECTION DAY WORKERS

Did you know that over 6,000 workers are necessary to assist our citizens with the voting process on Election Day in Broward County?

Here's how you can get involved...

JOB DESCRIPTIONS

POLLWORKERS:

CLERK - \$250

The Clerk manages overall tasks, activities and the pollworkers in the polling place; it is a supervisory position. Visits assigned precinct the day before the Election to setup the precinct with the VST and verifies all supplies have been delivered. Returns Election Day materials to assigned Regional Site on Election Night.

ASSISTANT CLERK - \$200

Assists the Clerk and shares his/her duties as needed and may substitute for the Clerk if they are unable to serve. Assists voters who need a Provisional Ballot.

EVID OPERATOR - \$185

Confirms voter eligibility in the EViD (Electronic Voter Identification Pollbook) at the check-in table and issues voting passes to eligible voters.

BALLOT INSPECTOR - \$180

Collects voting pass from each voter and issues appropriate ballot according to the ballot style on the voting pass. Issues voter a replacement ballot if error is made by the voter.

VOTING SYSTEM TECHNICIAN (VST) - \$250

Sets up the precinct the day before the Election with the Clerk; provides technical support to the voters on the Optical Scanner in the precinct or with the ExpressVote (ADA unit) on Election Day; and returns equipment and materials to assigned Regional Site on Election Night.

FIELD VOTING SYSTEM TECHNICIAN (FVST) - \$250 + MILEAGE

Attends training sessions, where Election Day materials and supplies are distributed. Responsible for contacting VSTs for assigned region before Election Day. Conducts site visits of assigned precincts on Election Day; completes site checklists; logs, VST status calls and provides support to VSTs throughout Election Day. Returns materials and supplies to specified Regional Site Election Night.

EARLY VOTING POLLWORKER

\$12 - \$18 HR. BASED ON POSITION

Performs overall tasks of an early voting site for two weeks prior to the election. Sets up and breaks down site, verifies voter's eligibility using the EViD (Electronic Voter Identification Pollbook) and issues ballots to the voters.

POLL DEPUTY - \$180

Maintains order outside the polling place. Posts signs/notices, monitors No Solicitation zone, stands at end of line at 7pm to signify end of voting day.

BILINGUAL POLLWORKERS - \$180

Communicates with voters whose first language is Spanish or Creole who may feel more comfortable speaking in their first language. Providing assistance if needed.

TRUCK DRIVERS / HELPERS \$150-\$175

Delivers and picks up equipment and supplies.

TRANSPORTERS - \$190 + MILEAGE

Picks up supplies for Election Day at Training Meeting prior to Election Day. Becomes familiar with geography of assigned area. Posts signs and/or delivers materials, supplies, etc. to assigned locations. Returns assigned materials to Voting Equipment Center after Polls close.

CALL CENTER OPERATORS:

Provide telephone support on Election Day and Election Night. May be assigned to one of the following Call Centers:

VOTER VERIFICATION - \$170

Responds to calls from Clerks/Assistant Clerks to determine voter eligibility.

TECHNICAL SUPPORT - \$190

Trained as a VST. Provides assistance to VST/FVST callers regarding the DS200 scanner, the EViDs and the ExpressVote (ADA unit). Gives direction and guidance to troubleshoot any challenges at the precincts.

Total payment next to each position includes payment for training. Training is not paid if you do not work Election Day.

Each worker is a part of our important democratic process by which we Americans select our leaders and have a voice in government.

In order to participate, you must be a registered Broward County voter. Just fill in the attached application and you will be scheduled to attend a training session. You will then be an eligible worker for future elections.
